

Traditional Stories

Folktales - a story that has been passed down from generation to generation by word of mouth

Type of Tale

Myth - a traditional story that was created to explain mysteries of the Universe

Characteristics

- often explains how something connected w/ humans or nature came to be
- reveals consequences of good & bad behavior
- features gods or other beings who have supernatural powers & certain flaws

Legend - A Story passed down through many generations that is believed to be based on real people and events

- tells about a hero / heroine who has unusual powers
- focuses on the hero's struggle to defeat a powerful force
- highlights a positive quality or way of behaving

Epic - a long, narrative poem, often written in formal language, that tells about a series of quests undertaken by a great hero

- follows a quest or journey of a hero who has incredible strength/courage
- focuses on the hero's character traits
- features hero's tasks such as battles in which the hero is tested

Fable - a brief story that teaches a lesson or moral about human nature

- usually includes animal characters that stand for specific human qualities
- has a moral that is directly stated at the end or indirectly communicated through what happens in the fable

Tall Tale - a humorously exaggerated story about impossible events

- stars a hero/heroin who is larger than life
- uses exaggeration to emphasize the abilities, achievements of the hero/heroin
